A lengthy consultation process involved several members of the School Development Team liaising with our own Design Team to draw up several play area designs as a funding bid was submitted. Without being certain of the level of funding available, the designs had to be flexible whilst consistently meeting the requirements of the Early Years' Curriculum.

2 playground developments were subsequently delivered, offering exceptional Early Years outdoor education. The adventurous woodlands now offer all ability access with a natural blend Flexiplay™ wet pour safety surfacing pathway which winds through the woods around the den making area, wigwam, willow den, bug busting and digging areas.
