Witton Park

The initial brief from Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council was to develop a flagship adventure play space.

Working alongside the main contractor UPM Tilhill on site, Pennine Playgrounds were contracted for the installation of the new equipment. The bespoke playground equipment was assembled on site, and where necessary modified to fit in with the natural topography of the landscape.

The play area incorporates various types of climbing net structures, pathways and aerial walkways, all linked together by rope bridges, bespoke timber platforms and tunnel slides.

The beautifully designed area is enhanced by welsh glacial boulders and the locally quarried stone used for the footpaths running through the features. Willow arches and fantastic wood carvings dotted around play zone are a sight to be seen and all add to the family orientated site.

Since opening, the park has won a prestigious BALI (British Association of Landscape Industries) award for 'Creation of a natural playscape and woodland adventure play facility' in the Hard Landscaping category for contracts between £300k and £1.5 million.
