

All parts are secure and that there is no excessive movement between them which may lead to finger traps and any other traps.												
Rotating or moving items are moving freely without wobbling or noise.												
All sliding surfaces are smooth and free from sharp edges along the entire sliding area.												
Impact absorbing surfaces are clean, not damaged and there are no signs of puddling or sharp objects												
All loose fill surfaces are at the required depth and level, with no signs of compaction.												
Grass mat surfacing is secure, without trip hazards and the grass beneath is not excessively worn.
